US COMPANY MOVING TO CANADA

CAMBRIA OPENS STATE-OF-THE-ART OPERATIONS IN TORONTO, ONTARIO

***Major Natural Quartz Countertop Enterprise to Bring 75 New Jobs to Toronto Area;
August 18 Grand Opening Event Featured Canadian Rockabilly Legend Ronnie Hawkins,
Who Helped Lead the US Company to Open in Canada***

MINNEAPOLIS/ST. PAUL (August 21, 2007) – Cambria, the only producer of natural quartz surfaces in the United States, opened a state-of-the-art operation in Bolton, Ontario, near Toronto.

To celebrate the opening of the new facility, Cambria hosted a VIP ribbon-cutting ceremony and concert with legendary Canadian rocker Ronnie Hawkins on Saturday, August 18 at the Bolton facility. Hawkins, widely credited for introducing rock-and-roll to Canada, is now credited for a major economic development coup for Canada. It was Hawkins, along with a Canadian born and raised Laurie Nelson of Toronto (who is a family member of the Davis family, the family who owns and operates Cambria) who are responsible for bringing Cambria to the Canadian market. Hawkins will serve as a spokesperson and ambassador for Cambria.

“We are excited to be opening major operations in Canada,” said Cambria CEO/President Marty Davis. “I am also excited that my good friend Ronnie Hawkins, a Canadian and international rock legend, is partnering with us to help introduce a new kind of rock to the Ontario marketplace.”

Cambria is a natural quartz surfacing product used for residential and commercial applications including countertops, shower and tub surrounds, vanities and flooring. The 68,000 square-foot facility will also manufacture custom-made furniture tabletops, fireplace surrounds, desk tops, coffee and end table tops, wet bar areas, and window sills. Cambria will initially need 75 new employees.

“Cambria is comprised of natural quartz from right here in Canada, and because it is further processed in Ontario, it is a genuine locally-made product,” Davis said. “The housing market and the strong local economy make Ontario an ideal location for our \$4 million new fabrication facility. Ours is a family business and we love Canada. My sister-in-law hails from the Toronto area and is a die-hard loyal Canadian, as well she should be. Canada is a great country with wonderful people and now I have a niece who is both Canadian and American.”

Cambria is a Minnesota company with multiple operations in the United States and Canada including locations in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and North Carolina. Cambria is available through builders, designers/architect and kitchen/bath retailers throughout all of North America.
