CAMBRIA DONATES 322 SQUARE FEET OF NATURAL QUARTZ SURFACES TO REYNOLDS HOME RENOVATION

New Home For Family in Need Scheduled to Be Complete February 23

EUGENE, OREGON (February 13, 2007) – Cambria, the only producer of natural quartz surfaces in the U.S., is donating its product to be used in five rooms as part of a custom home being built for the Reynolds family by the Home Builders Association of Lane County. The Reynolds family is scheduled to move in to the home February 23.

The Reynolds family, which has a severely disabled 18-year-old son, Jason, and an ailing grandfather who has been living in a trailer in the family's driveway, originally applied to the ABC television show "Extreme Makeover: Home Edition." When the Home Builders Association learned that it would be a year before the application was considered, it decided to move ahead with the project and is working with several companies to build the 3,444 square-foot custom home for the family in Springfield's Hayden Bridge area.

"When we heard about this project we immediately wanted to get involved," said Linda Joens, Oregon Market Representative for Cambria. "Cambria surfaces not only offer the Reynolds family a fabulous look throughout their home, but also a safe, non-porous surface that doesn't require frequent maintenance with chemicals."

Cambria is a stain-resistant, non-porous surface that is harder, stronger and easier to care for than granite, limestone and marble because it does not require sealing. Cambria is certified by NSF International for food preparation – there is no safer surface available to consumers. In addition, Cambria has been GreenGuard Indoor Air Quality Certified® by the GreenGuard Environmental Institute (GEI). GEI verified that Cambria natural quartz surfaces do not emit harmful levels of chemicals into the environment.

More than 320 square feet of the Cambria quartz surfaces, a value of \$13,000, will be used in the project. A variety of colors as well as new uses for Cambria will be utilized throughout the home including a desk top. Classique Marble & Granite donated their labor to fabricate and install the product.

Cambria has a history of supporting important community projects and its product was used in recent episodes of “Extreme Makeover: Home Edition.”

“We have always believed in giving back to the community and this project enables us to improve the lives of this family,” Joens said.

Cambria will be used in the following areas:

- The main kitchen features Cambria’s Ashford™ on the countertops.
- Grandpa’s living area will feature Bristol Blue™ countertops by Cambria in the kitchen.
- A bathroom vanity counter and study desk for Jason’s brother Joel will feature Cambria’s Flint Black™.
