Combining natural quartz with binders and pigments, Cambria delivers exceptional strength, beauty, and versatility—backed by industry-leading design innovation and American craftsmanship.

IS CAMBRIA A NATURAL STONE? Cambria is made from pure natural quartz, pigments, and binders. Quartz is the extremely hard mineral that gives Cambria its strength. Our unique process results in a quartz product of uncommon elegance, style, and superior durability.

HOW IS CAMBRIA DIFFERENT FROM OTHER QUARTZ BRANDS? Cambria is family owned and made in the USA, and also offers exclusive designs you won't find anywhere else, industry-leading quality, and a transferable Full Lifetime Warranty.

WHERE CAN I USE CAMBRIA? Kitchens, bathrooms, laundry rooms—anywhere you need a beautiful, durable surface.

IS CAMBRIA SEAMLESS? Cambria's slab sizes differ based on the design; the use of seams will vary based on slab size and application. **Note:** there may be a visible pattern and shade change at each seam.

CAN I SEE A FULL SLAB BEFORE I BUY? Absolutely. You can request to see a full slab at select showrooms or fabricators to get the full impact of the design.

Care & Performance

DOES CAMBRIA REQUIRE CARE AND MAINTENANCE? No. Staying true to its care-free promise, Cambria requires no sealing, polishing, or reconditioning. Cleaning is as simple as wiping with warm water, a soft cotton cloth, and mild soap, if desired.

DOES CAMBRIA WITHSTAND HEAT? CAN I PUT A HOT PAN OR POT ON IT? Like all stone surfaces, Cambria can be damaged by sudden temperature changes or direct, sustained heat—especially at the edges. Always use a trivet or hot pad under hot pots, pans, and appliances like air fryers, griddles, and slow cookers to protect the surface.

IS CAMBRIA RESISTANT TO SURFACE DAMAGE? Cambria is more resistant to surface damage than other stone, but no surface is chip- or scratch-proof. Forceful impacts may cause chips. Cambria is scratch resistant, though markings can still occur and are more visible on monotone designs than on multicolored surfaces.

IS CAMBRIA SAFE FOR FOOD PREPARATION? Yes, Cambria is nonabsorbent and is NSF/ANSI 51 Certified for food and splash zones in kitchens. Its nonporous nature means it won't harbor bacteria, making it a hygienic choice for food prep. Although Cambria is scratch resistant, we recommend using a cutting board to preserve the surface's finish and protect your knives.

DOES CAMBRIA STAIN? Cambria's nonporous and nonabsorbent surface is resistant to staining and eliminates the need for any sealing. Its nonporous surface also greatly reduces the potential for bacterial growth from food absorbing into your countertop.

IS THERE ANY DIFFERENCE IN PERFORMANCE BETWEEN CAMBRIA'S FINISH OPTIONS? All of Cambria's finishes provide the same high level of performance. This means you can select the finish that best suits your style without compromising on performance.
